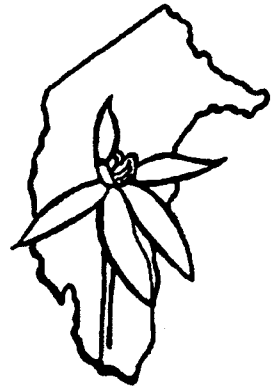

The Editor's Comment

Welcome to the last Bulletin for the year. Later in the Bulletin you will find the Show Results, and if you check through them you will see that Canberra performed very well in the competition.

Whilst I did not see much of the Conference I did catch up with Grant Smith of Orchidaceous Books. He recommended a book to me, Orchids of the High Mountain Rain Forest in South Eastern Brazil: A Field and Hobbyist Guide, which I bought. This book is a survey of the Orchids of a limited area of Brazil, however in the detail of the information it provides for the hobbyist places it in a unique position.

Knowing the country of origin of an orchid is of little use unless you are told where the plant is found. This little book provides extensive information about the plant habitats, including altitude, light levels and relative humidity. As such it provides a great service to the hobby grower.

Better yet is the inclusion of details about how the plant grows in the wild. Is the plant robust or relatively delicate? Does it overrun its neighbours in its exertions? This book will be of use to many in the society as it provides much information about the orchids, including many genera which are not currently popular, of a small but distinct area. Whatever orchids we grow we must always remain aware of their original habitats. From these we can gain a greater understanding of how to provide an environment in which the plant can thrive and prosper.

From the President....

Hello everyone, this is the last Bulletin until January '96 so please hang on to it for referring to dates of activities. This Bulletin will take us over Christmas and the hot summer when orchids will need care and the humidity kept up for them in their orchid houses. We have scoria on the floor which I water twice or more a day depending on the temperature. In the shade house this has encouraged moss to grow (which seems to take the winter weather) and encourage more humidity. When it gets too hot, say over 32°C, I put my Masdevallias under the house - it keeps about 10°C cooler there - then I bring them out at night to get some air. My Natives, Cymbidiums, flowering size Catleas and Zygos all go out in the shade house from about the middle of November onwards depending on the weather. My four Stanhopeas hang under the back veranda. All of my young orchids stay in the orchid house and I use a BonAir cooler when it gets too hot. I mist the plants in the evening to help them cool down - everything here is geared to orchid comfort! Of course fertilising is important so I use half strength Campbells Blue or Thrive once a week after watering first.

SHOW REPORT

Jean Egan reported on the Conference and indicated that the Interstate visitors enjoyed the show and thought that the speakers were excellent.

Jane Wright thanked all those members who had helped with the show especially those members on the Show Committee. Jane said that there had been 433 items judged by a total of 14 judges, 4 Society displays, and 27 Canberra people put orchids in the Show. In addition the participation rate by members this year had been very good with 50 people registering for the Show and 68 people attend the Dinner on the Saturday night. The members will be interested to know that there were approximately 1,200 people who visited the Show and that \$2,500 was taken at the door. It had been decided in Committee that the commission for plant sales should be dropped from 20% to 10%, and consequently there was ~~\$800~~ taken on plant sale

commission. In addition to this there was also \$850 taken for refreshments. Jane advised that a list of plants winning 1st and 2nd will be published in the Bulletin.

The trophies were then awarded to the proud owners of the winning orchids which made quite a highlight to the evening's events. In conclusion Jane passed back her Show Convener's badge since she will be unable to do it next year.
