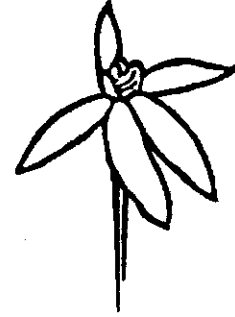

Unfortunately, the CIT decided to reduce drastically the proportions of their autumn event and societies are no longer invited. It would be a very big step for the Society to put

Thanks to the assistance of committee member Lila Rose, it has been arranged that our Society will participate in the Autumn Show of the Horticultural Society of Canberra on 8-9 March 1997. The Horticultural Society has been very enthusiastic and helpful, because they see that it would also be of benefit to them to have the orchids there. The cost to the Society for our participation will basically be what it costs for our own judges, so it is a good way to try out and see how we would go with an autumn show. We'll have all the details for you in the New Year.

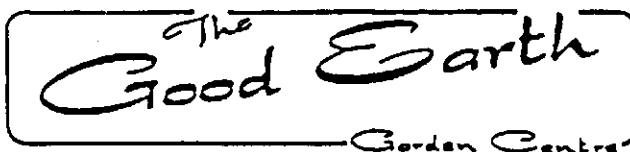
